She does the washing and cleans around the house. She also has a garden with local plants. In fact, we have acquired some plants for our garden from hers. The people of our pueblo are sharing people and glad to help each other out. It is nice to have the time to spend with our neighbors.



We have another family we would like you to pray with us about: Walker and Maritza. He was here from the United States doing some work some 40 years ago and met a pretty, young Honduran lady and they married. After the work was completed, they returned to the US... After retirement they decided to come back and now live in the house, she grew up in. They have been here for some time enjoying their retirement. She has family here in the village and enjoys spending time with them. Unfortunately, Walker has contracted Parkinson's disease. His health has diminished so he is house bound and not able to get out much. We visit with them to relieve the boredom and catch up. He loves to study the Bible and we often converse about his studies. We recently made lunch for them and, with our make-shift picnic basket, took it to their home.
