So we will be returning to Ohio to undergo a chemotherapy treatment plan at the end of November. We will quarantine for two weeks and begin treatments in December. We anticipate the program will take about 5 months. We are blessed with a place to stay for the duration of our program.

We trust this is the Lord's guidance and we trust Him for a good outcome. We appreciate your prayers and support as we navigate this time in our lives. We look forward to returning to Honduras to complete what the Lord has called us to do that we love so much.
